The criteria used by Ditto Trade to accept a Master Trader

In order for an individual to be accepted as a Master Trader, they must verify that they have experience in trading the markets and have a validated track record. Master Trader's go through a background check that includes, (but is not limited to) credit, criminal and regulatory. All Master Traders have to sign a "Master Trader Designate and Software License Agreement".

A Master Trader candidate must provide the following:

- ➤ Proof of a minimum of five (5) years trading experience.
- Validation of trading results
- Three (3) references from within the financial services industry.
- A written overview of their trading style, methodology, and risk management philosophy.
